



**SUBMITTING WAITING CHILD APPLICATION**

**Make copies of all documents for your own records**

If you have a current approved adoption application with Dillon International, please submit:

- Waiting Child Application-part #1.

If you do not have a current approved adoption application with Dillon International, please submit:

- Adoption Application-part #1 and supplemental documents
- Waiting Child Application-part #1
- Copy of current approved home study and/or previous home study (if applicable)
- Copy of current approval notice for I-600A or I-800A (if applicable)

**PROCESSING WAITING CHILD APPLICATION**

Upon pre-approval of your application, the Waiting Child Coordinator will send you the child’s background and medical information. If you decide you want to be considered to adopt the child, you will be asked to submit the original application documents and fee to Dillon International. The application fee is waived for families with a current approved application with Dillon and families who have previously adopted through Dillon/Buckner.

**DISCLOSURE**

Please keep in mind that there may be other families that are also looking at the information on this children. If, after reviewing the child’s complete background and medical information, a family wishes to adopt the child, the child will be placed on hold. Due to the many inquiries we receive about waiting children, we want you to know that if more than one family wants to be considered to adopt a child, the Social Work Committee at Dillon International will determine the family they believe has the ability to best meet the needs of the child. If all things appear to be equal, preference may be given to a family based upon various factors (e.g., paperwork readiness, access to quality health care, family experience, etc.).

\*\* Dillon International encourages families to follow birth order. We ask that families have at least one year of age difference between the youngest child in the home and a new child entering the family and at least one year between placements. If you are interested in a child that is not younger than the youngest child currently in your home or is not at least one year apart in age, you will need approval from Dillon's Social Work committee.
